English manuals	English textbooks will be handed out directly by the teachers at the beginning of the school year.
Dress Code for Sport	Each student from Petite Section to Terminale receives a sport shirt, which must be ordered by families. Additional units can be ordered at any time using the Price & Buckland platform (Fournitures scolaires – Lycée Claudel L'école française internationale d'Ottawa Lycée Claudel L'école française internationale d'Ottawa). Orders placed before June 30th will be delivered to the home during the summer before the start of the school year. Students from CP to Terminale wear specific attire for sports activities: a Lycée Claudel polo, black sports shorts or pants (to be obtained from the store of your choice), and shoes reserved for outdoor and/or indoor sports. Access to gymnasiums will only be permitted with clean sports shoes reserved for this sole purpose.

School Restaurant

<p>For this new school year, Lycée Claudel will be working with a new provider, the company Aramark, bringing several new features, including 30% organic products, the availability of an unlimited salad bar, a collective service in preschool, and no use of disposable tableware, etc.</p> <p>Discover the meal plans on the school's website. Families can also visit Lycée Claudel on August 28th from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM to purchase meal plans on-site if they prefer this option or if they have any questions for the new school restaurant provider.</p>

Padlocks (for secondary level only)

Plan to buy 2 sturdy and secure padlocks (1 for your school locker and 1 for the gym locker room). Combination locks are recommended. The lockers will be assigned by the Student Life Department at the beginning of the school year

School Bags

Bags on wheels are strongly discouraged since they're not adapted to the configuration of the school (many stairs) and are often oversized for the students' lockers.
